The Institute of Life Long Learning, University of Delhi organized a computer awareness workshop for students of NCWEB on 16 & 17 November 2016. 34 students participated in the workshop. Mr. R.K. Vyas ICT Co-ordinator, conducted the workshop in which the following topics were covered

1. Introduction to Computers
2. MS-Word
3. Ms Excel
4. Networking, Internet & Email
5. How to navigate vle.du.ac.in

Mr. Vyas covered various aspects of computation, word-processing, how to create the worksheet, Internet resources for research etc. He also demonstrated the variety of e-resources available in the different disciplines in the form of e-lessons, video lectures etc. on the vle.du.ac.in site and showed sample e-resources from different subjects, also informed that number of new topics will be added in the near future.

The students were given more than 90 minutes for hands-on practice to explore the site (vle.du.ac.in). They were also asked to give their feedback about the course. The students were quite satisfied.
