

Capacity-Building Workshop on Computer Science

The Institute of Lifelong Learning, University of Delhi organized a half-day Capacity-Building Workshop on Computer Science on 30th September 2016. The theme of the workshop was “Computer Science and The Use of Internet for Research”. It was conducted by Ms. Fatema Siddiqua, Lecturer Computer Engg., Govt. Polytechnic, Ghaziabad. The aim of this workshop was the capacity building of researchers for using computers and the Internet and to give a basic introduction to computer science to those who are not from CS background and to first year CS students. The workshop was attended by 20 teachers and 16 students from various DU colleges.

The following topics from the CBCS syllabus of GE-3 (Computer Networks and Internet Technologies) paper were covered. The talk was divided into three parts:

1. Introduction to Computer Science
2. Introduction to Computer Networks
3. The Use of Internet for Research.

It was followed by a hands-on session to practice all the tools and techniques just learned and to access the repositories available on the Internet including vle.du.ac.in, the ILLL repository of e-Learning. The tools available for researchers demonstrated in the workshop include:

1. Social Media in Research
2. Digital Libraries
3. Online Repositories
4. Online Plagiarism Checkers
5. Online Language Translators
6. Online Surveys and Forms
7. How to use Google Scholar for effective searching, and
8. How to create a Google Form for conducting surveys

The workshop ended with distribution of certificates by Director, ILLL and a vote of thanks to the participants.
